Unfortunately, Mike's beer will not be included in the 2008 winners' six-pack. As yet another repercussion to this year's widely reported hop shortage, Sam Adams was unable to secure the 7 West Coast hops used in Mike's recipe. Per an agreement between Mike and Jim Koch, his Double IPA will be included in the 2009 six-pack. Always thinking, Mike asked if a few kegs from the pilot brew could be shipped to Concord for a local

We've discussed the many benefits of competition regularly at club meetings. If you would like feedback on your beers, tips for improving, or just want to see how your beer stacks up against others then you are in luck as the competition season is in full swing. There are several upcoming events with local judging which means no shipping fees and the opportunity to attend some of the events:

World Cup of Beer, Berkeley CA - Run by BAM, this is an excellent local event. Entries are due 3/8 at MoreBeer.

Mayfaire, Woodland Hills CA - Run by the Maltose Falcons, this is the first of 3 events culminating in the California Homebrewer of the Year award. Entries are 3/27 due at Morebeer.

AHA Club Only Comp - The March/April style is any extract beer. DOZE will judge entries at our 3/31 meeting with the winner representing the club in the national judging.

Brewer Spotlight

Who? **Jesse Warren**
Years brewing: 1.5
Favorite style: IPA

Many of us know Jesse as the helpful guy behind the MoreBeer counter, more than willing to

discuss ingredients or to help you locate that missing piece of hardware to make your brew system complete. But on top of that Jesse is a serious brewer, knocking down 2 to 8 brews per week! It's probably no surprise that he brews on a B3

1550 brew sculpture, but when asked for some tidbits we might not know he just laughed and said, "I used to drink Budweiser before I started homebrewing." Jesse's favorite aspect of homebrewing is "fire and stainless," two things he spends a lot of time around with a brew schedule like his.
